Participants are expected to have completed initial HF training and have circa 2 years of work experience within a Part 145 organisation.

This professional development training programme is designed to facilitate compliance with IR 145.A.35(d) (or equivalent IR). It would provide participants with a qualitative understanding of relevant changes to the Part 145 IRs (including AMCs and GMs as applicable) from the preceding 2 years, as well as a review of human factors in aircraft maintenance. Furthermore, the programme will include an interactive workshop session designed to facilitate best practices and constructive feedback reporting in relation to the previously referenced training elements.

-  Relevant AMCs & GMs to the above changes
-  Review of the concept of human factors
-  The need to remain proactive about HF
-  Review of MEMS & Just Culture Principles
-  Best practices for mitigating HF in AM
